ECTA, together with EAASDC member clubs, hosts the ECTA Student Jamboree annually.

Objective:

Students should be able to participate in a larger event during their training. Among other things they can get to know:

- Registration
- Dancing with dancers they don't know to callers they don't know
- Learning to think outside the box, ECTA does not only do square dancing
- Flyer tables (collecting flyers for themselves and their club)
- Grand March

Date: Last Saturday in March.

If this day is Holy Saturday, then the event date is the Saturday before Holy Saturday.

Place:

This event takes place in a different region every year. To enable as many clubs and their students as possible to participate, the following applies for

- Years with an even number: Student Jamboree North/South
- years with an odd number: Student Jamboree central

Program:

The dance program includes the complete basic program of CALLERLAB. During the event we enable with introductions to get acquainted with the dance styles "Round Dance", "Clogging Dance" and "Contra and Traditional Square Dance", which are also represented by ECTA.

Profit/Loss:

After the event carried out according to the planned specifications:

- Profit to be shared equally by host club and ECTA.
- Loss is borne by ECTA.

Application:

The ECTA Square Dance Coordinator (square-dance-coordinator@ecta.de)

- answers inquiries,
- sends out the appropriate application forms
- and accepts applications

The ECTA Executive Board, along with the ECTA Square Dance Coordinator, reviews available applications and decides on the award.
