# **Equipment (Part II)**

#### Seminar content:

### Different kinds of equipment

- HILTON, Jack's PA
- Behringer, Bose, Yamaha, ...
- Mixer with active speakers (e.g. Dynacord)
- Others

#### <u>Inputs</u>

- Mike inputs separate volume control
- Line input for: Laptop, MP3-Player, Smartphone, etc

#### **Outputs**

- Loudspeakers (Active & Passive)
  - Passive: Impedance has match to amplifier (ex. Hilton=4 ohm), never mix different makes/kind of loudspeakers
  - Active: separate output necessarily, possibility mixing different kind of equipment,
- Main channel and Monitor channel
- Monitor speakers (on stage)
- Line output (high, low) depending on which model
- Output for recording, hearing aid f. ex. Monacor etc)

#### Connecting speakers

- Power (watts)
- Impedance (ohms) (need to know for passive loudspeakers)
- ½ Yak = 9,6 ohms; full Yak with parallel adaptor 4,8 ohms
- Y adaptor (serial) if using passive loudspeakers
- Connectors: Speak on (passive loudspeaker)



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#### Cables for

- Loudspeakers
- Microphone
- Adapter for Music source: e.g. Laptop / Smartphone /
- Recording

#### Using wireless microphone

- Connecting the wireless to the set up
- Avoid feedback: switch on transmitter and receiver first, and then turn volume up while talking into the mike

## What to do when acoustics are bad and/or dancers cannot understand

- First step: turn music volume lower
- Second step: turn your microphone volume lower
- Third step: check position of loudspeakers
- With monitor speakers on stage: be careful with your microphone to avoid feedback

### Preparing for a dance

Position for leader / set up / speakers in the hall More leaders on stage: turn volume of microphones down
